

ISC 10TH ANNUAL AND REGIONAL SCRIPPS SPELLING BEE

10th Annual and Regional Scripps Spelling Bee for North Cook, South Cook, and West 40 ISC.

The requirements for participation in the ISC 10th Annual and Regional Scripps Spelling Bee Events are as follows:

- Welcome all spellers! Participating elementary, public, private and home schooled programs must register online with the Scripps National Spelling Bee (www.spellingbee.com). Scripps has a comprehensive video reviewing the enrollment process.
- The enrollment fee is \$147 per school (public and private) and \$155 for individual home-schooled programs. Once enrolled, Scripps provides access to everything you need to organize classroom and school spelling bees. Scripps does not accept purchase orders; payment may be made by check or credit card. If paying by check, a \$7.50 handling fee will apply.
- A Spelling Bee Coordinator is recommended as the point person for your district to receive all future Spelling Bee correspondence.
- Each district can only send **“ONE”** winner to our 10th Annual Scripps ISC Spelling Bee event.
- The Spelling Bee Coordinator needs to complete the **DISTRICT WINNER REGISTRATION FORM** which can be found on the South Cook ISC web page (www.s-cook.org) under the heading Parents/Community. Please scroll down and locate the link for “SPELLING BEE,” and select either the North Cook, South Cook, or West 40 form. At the bottom of this registration form you need to check “I’m not a robot,” prior to submission.
- All District/Private or Home-Schooled programs must complete the District Winner Registration process on line at (www.s-cook.org), prior to January 20, 2020.
- The student winner and spelling bee coordinator will receive a confirmation notice electronically, as to the date, time and location for participation in the 10th Annual ISC Scripps Spelling Bee event.
- The South Cook, North Cook, and West 40 10th Annual ISC Scripps Spelling Bee events will be held during the first week in February 2020.
- Our 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners from each of our annual events will advance to our 10th Regional ISC Championship Event. The 10th Regional ISC Scripps Spelling Bee will be held at McClure Junior High School in Western Springs on February 20, 2020.
- Location and dates for all our events are available on the Scripps website (www.spellingbee.com).
- Our Regional ISC Scripps Spelling Bee Champion and one parent will be sent to the National Scripps Spelling Bee in Washington, DC, May 2020. This is as a result of the generous grant award funded by our corporate sponsor ComEd.
- The National Scripps Spelling Bee finals are broadcast live in prime time on ESPN and ESPN 3.
